Required Documentation

PeerPoint requires the following documents:

2. A Conflict of Interest (COI) form for each positive financial disclosure by a presenter, planner, editor, or staff, duly filled out by a peer reviewer.
3. A digital copy of 1 example of sales or marketing material containing the Accreditation Statement and Designation Statement.
4. A digital copy of any conference book or educational material containing Accreditation Statement and Designation Statement and all financial disclosure information by presenter, planners, editors, or staff.
5. A digital file with the Bio of each presenter. A bio consist of the presenter's name, titles and any other qualifications pertinent to their presentation.
6. A digital file containing the second slide or page of each presentation that is part of the activity (live or enduring), showing the Presenter's disclosure information. The CME Vault will not be initiated until this file is received.
